Preliminary plans:

All floats will gather on St Ann Avenue unless they are horse drawn. Horse drawn floats will assemble on Cliffwood Street. **Dave Roche** is the organizer.

Parade will assemble at 9:00 AM at the correct location. Parade will start at 11:00 AM *sharp*. If you're late, you may or may not get in. The parade coordinator, **John McNinch**, will make that decision. He will be located on Main Street next to Triangle Park.

We will have a parade organizer at every setup point; they will communicate with parade coordinator John McNinch. One parade representative for each setup location will communicate with that organizer leader.

Parade will merge at Triangle Park on to Main Street with everything entering from the four setup points:

- Lenox Highway Department (Motorized Vehicles)
- Church-on-the-Hill, Greenwood Street (Marchers and Bands)
- St. Ann's Avenue (Non Horse Drawn Floats)
- Cliffwood Street (All HORSE Drawn Wagons, Floats and Carriages)

Franklin Street (Grand Marshall Car).

Public viewing for the Parade will be from Triangle Park on Main Street to the main entrance to Shakespeare & Co., 70 Kemble Street, on both sides of the streets. We hope to have a Viewing Stand in front of the Adams Community Bank.

The parade will consist of floats, fire trucks, ambulance vehicles, police vehicles, antique cars & trucks, high school bands, other bands, horse wagons and carriages, organizations, VFW, etc.

To enter the parade, complete the attached application and return it to the address below. There will be no fee charged for entries this year. **The deadline to register is September 23, 2016.**

There will be three float categories evaluated by the Judges. Awards will be given as follows:

- Best Overall Entry (Grand Champion) the most original in design and theme attractiveness
- 2. **Theme Entry** best exemplifying this year's theme
- 3. Spirit Entry displaying the most enthusiasm during judging

The winners will be notified at the gathering at Shakespeare & Co., 70 Kemble Street.

Walking groups in the parade lineup will separate motorized floats, and we will try to maintain a smooth, SLOW pace. The approximate speed will be two (2) miles per hour. Also, please be very careful of pedestrians along the parade route as children often dart out to gather candy (**soft candies only**) tossed out. (All soft candy must be wrapped) Floats will be judged in front of the Adams Community Bank on Main Street. Lineup will begin at 9:00 AM with judging beginning at 10:30 AM.

Teachers, leaders, and parents are responsible for seeing that all persons involved in their groups are made aware of all the regulations and parking limitations. The important rule is to be PATIENT, COURTEOUS, and to have a lot of FUN.
